

## Policy Proposal



### Problem

- Low income area Green Stormwater
   Infrastructure is less well maintained than that in high income areas
- Those in less advantaged areas feel that they have a lower stake in their community's overall environmental health

# Situational Factors

- Philadelphia is a very stratified city with many different neighborhoods with different neighborhood characteristics
- Taxes inform maintenance and low income communities pay fewer taxes in volume
- Governments want to implement these infrastructure quickly and therefore don't take the time to get the feedback of the citizens
