





## My Story

- Often not just the students online, but also parents, grandparents, cousins, and neighbors.







Figure 1. Percentage of children ages 3-5 and not yet in kindergarten whose parents reported participating in home activities with child three or more times in the past week (N=954)






Figure 5. Coefficients from regression of engagement outcomes on instructional strategies and social capital.




# William L. Sayre High School

- 2,826 students in the catchment.



## Findings

- Semi-structured interview.
- Stay at home mom, immigrant family.
- Two children.
- Extended family, modest living area.
- Contrary to literature, did not seem to struggle with isolation.
